NOTICE OF POSTING OF ORDINANCE SUBMITTAL

TO: THE RESIDENTS AND PROPERTY OWNERS OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF OSHTEMO, KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN, AND ANY OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, in accordance with Public Act 359 of 1947, as amended, the Oshtemo Charter Township Board has determined the method of publication of its Ordinances will be by posting the Ordinance in the Office of the Township Clerk and on the Township's web page.

In accordance with the Board's policy, a proposed amendment to the Township Wastewater Service Ordinance No. 208, as amended, being Compiled Section 232.000, Section 232.008 Timing of Connections, has been submitted to the Board which, if passed, would allow abutting property owners to wait to connect to available sanitary sewer until 24 months following the installation of the sewer main and publication of notice of availability, or to connect within 24 months of mailed notification of the availability of sanitary sewer.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the full text of the proposed Ordinance has been posted for public inspection at the Office of the Township Clerk located at 7275 West Main Street, Kalamazoo, Michigan, 49009, and on the Township's web page at www.oshtemo.org

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that said Ordinance will be considered for adoption by the Oshtemo Charter Township Board at its meeting to be held on September 8, 2020, commencing at 7:15 p.m. This meeting will take place virtually due to the Governor Whitmer's Executive Orders unless a public meeting is permitted, in which case, the public hearing will be held at the Township Hall. If the meeting is held virtually, the access link will be available on Oshtemo Charter Township's home page on the Township website.

Oshtemo Charter Township will provide necessary reasonable auxiliary aids and services, such as signers for the hearing impaired and audio tapes of printed materials being considered at the meeting, to individuals with disabilities at the meeting/hearing upon seven (7) days' notice to Oshtemo Charter Township. Individuals with disabilities requiring auxiliary aids or services should contact Oshtemo Charter Township by writing or calling the Township.

All interested parties are invited to be present at the aforesaid time and place to participate in discussion upon said Ordinance.
